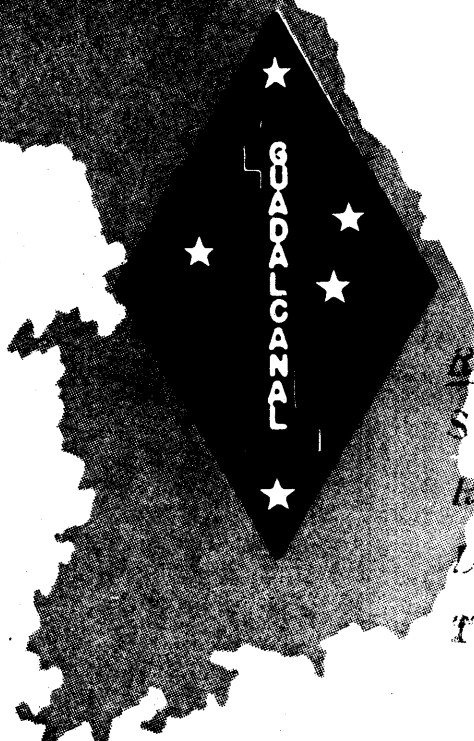

- e. Sups dispersed within dumps. Ammo to be stored in pits or revetments. Sups subj to weathering to be placed under cover or on dry deck or dunnage. Sups subj to damage by extreme heat to be protected by refig where pract.
